Mary Wollstonecraft (27 April 1759 – 10 September 1797) was an English writer, philosopher, and advocate of women's rights. Until the late 20th century, Wollstonecraft's life, which encompassed several unconventional personal relationships, received more attention than her writing. The poet and essayist Mary Chudleigh (1656-1710) is buried in the church of St John the Baptist, Higher Ashton, Devon. The Chudleigh vault is in the small side chapel to the left of the altar – according to the guidebook it's situated below the 15th century wall painting – but there is no memorial to her.
