Leonardo da Pisa, auch Fibonacci genannt (* um 1170 in Pisa; † nach 1240 ebenda), war Rechenmeister in Pisa und gilt als einer der bedeutendsten Mathematiker des Mittelalters. Liber Abaci (also spelled as Liber Abbaci) ("The Book of Calculation") is a 1202 historic book on arithmetic by Leonardo of Pisa, posthumously known as Fibonacci. In the Liber Abaci (1202), Fibonacci introduced the so-called modus Indorum (method of the Indians), today known as the Hindu–Arabic numeral system. Leonardo Pisano is better known by his nickname Fibonacci. He was the son of Guilielmo and a member of the Bonacci family. Fibonacci himself sometimes used the name Bigollo, which may mean good-for-nothing or a traveller., Fibonacci S Liber Abaci.
